The purpose of this project is to help Elbert/Douglas County 4-Hers to begin or increase a beef herd. To qualify for this project, the 4-Her must submit a letter and budget to EDCLA. The participants will be selected and announced at fair during Awards Night. The livestock association co-signs a bank note (valued up to \$400.00) towards the purchase of a bred heifer. The animal is displayed as a cow/calf pair at the fair. The cow/calf pair are not shown at halter nor groomed at fair. This is to be a "true life" experience of beef production.
