

## Small Fry Animal Classes

### Rules:

1. Contestant age is limited to 3-7 year olds.
2. Each entry must include a Minor Release signed by parent/guardian.
3. Education of the “small fry” in animal welfare is the responsibility of the parent/guardian. Any violations of proper animal handling will result in intervention by the superintendent and/or ring men.
4. No costumes or adornment allowed on animals, as there is a Pet Animal Costume class held on Sunday, August 2.
5. Exhibitor is encouraged to be attired as a regular showman as suggested in the specie section under showmanship.
6. **Each class will be held prior to 4-H Showmanship Classes of that specie.**
  - a. Check-in will be 15 minutes prior to show.
  - b. Animals are released immediately following class.
7. Participation ribbons will be given to each contestant, as well as an opportunity for review and comments from judge. There will be no placing ribbons awarded in this event.
